21 + 3 LOCAL JACKPOT

The rules for Blackjack 21+3 Local Jackpot at this casino (set out below) are our commitment to the players in ensuring that the gambling we offer is 'Fair and Open' in accordance with the licensing objectives of the Gambling Act 2005. In the event of a dispute resulting from any ambiguity in the rules, the decision shall always be in the player's favor until such time that ambiguity has been resolved.

21+3 LOCAL JACKPOT WAGER

- To make this wager a player must also make a standard blackjack wager.
- This wager is that the player's first two cards combined with the Dealer's first card forms a Three Card Poker hand of a straight or better.
- If the player's first two cards combined with the Dealer's first card forms a Three Card Poker hand of a straight or better, they will be paid the amounts below for their stake.

HAND	£1 STAKE	£5 STAKE	£10 STAKE
Three of a Kind – Aces, Kings or Queens	100% of Jackpot	100% of Jackpot	100% of Jackpot
Three of a Kind - Other	£125	£625	£1250
Straight Flush	£25	£125	£250
Three of a Kind – Off suit	£20	£100	£200
Straight	£6	£30	£60
Flush	£2	£10	£20

- If the Player's hand does not hit one of the above rankings, the 21+3 Local Jackpot wager will lose.
- Only the highest hand formed from each player's ranking hand with the Dealer's first card will be paid out.
- If there are two or more winning 'Jackpot' hands on the same table during the same round, the Jackpot total will be shared equally amongst those winning players.
- In the event of a misdeal all wagers are void.
- This is a shared Jackpot within this property, with all bets placed contributing to the Jackpot meter.

A PLAYER'S GUIDE TO THE HOUSE EDGE

The House Edge is a measure of how much the House expects to win, expressed as a percentage of the player's wager. For example, in a wager with a House Edge of five percent the player will lose on average over time, £5 for every £100 wagered. House Edges vary by region, casino, and game. In some games, player betting or skills decisions can affect the Edge, but it is important to keep in mind that the House always has some advantage against the typical player.
